This Privacy policy applies to professional events for natural persons applying on the website (ww.nftdeb.art) maintained by the Data Controller, as well as to data processing related to personal data provided for the purpose of sending a message for contact purposes.

For the purposes of this prospectus, personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (the Data Subject). A natural person can be who is, directly or indirectly identifiable, based on an identifier (such as name, number, location, online identifier or one or more factors relating to the natural person's physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity).

As a general rule, the personal data of the data subject may be disclosed to the employees of the Data Controller in order to perform their duties. For example, the data management staff of the Data Manager are the organizers involved in the process for the purpose of organizing. Personal data will be transferred to the above mentioned Recipients. The Data Controller only transfer the personal data of the data subject to other state organisations in exceptional cases. Thus, for example, if a legal dispute between the data subject and the Data Controller involves legal proceedings and the trial court requires the transfer of documents containing the data subject's personal data, the police will contact the Data Controller and request the transfer of documents containing the data subject's personal data for investigation. In addition, for example, a lawyer representing the Data Controller will also have access to the personal data in the event of a dispute between the data subject and the Data Controller.

4., Time of storage of personal data

Until the withdrawal of the data management consent, but not later than 3 years after the application or sending of the contact message, if the Data Subject has not stated the possibility of requesting further professional programs. If you have agreed to further inquiries, in this case until the date of the waiver given by the Data Subject.

5., Other

Personal data is transferred to a third country and not to an international organization. No automated decision-making or profiling takes place during the processing of personal data detailed in this Data Management Information.

By applying by e-mail to the application e-mail address on the website, you (or the parent exercising parental custody in the case of a child) consent to the processing (ie recording, recording, systematization, storage, use, retrieval, transmission, blocking, deletion, destruction, prevention of further use of the data).

The provision of personal data is at your discretion, however, in the absence of your full name and email address, we cannot accept registration. You can withdraw your consent voluntarily at any time, but the withdrawal of your consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing prior to the withdrawal. Incomplete, contradictory or incomprehensible notation shall be construed by the Data Controller as a refusal of consent.

The processing of personal data of a child under the age of 16 in connection with the use of information society services is lawful only if and to the extent that the consent has been given or authorized by the person exercising parental supervision over the child.

6., Rights of the data subject

The Company will comply with your written request to exercise your rights (which may be sent by e-mail to the info@nftdeb.art e-mail address or by post) within a maximum of one

month of receipt. The date of receipt of the application does not count towards the deadline. If necessary, taking into account the complexity of the application and the number of applications, the Company may extend this deadline by another two months. The Company shall inform the data subject of the extension of the deadline, indicating the reasons for the delay, within one month from the receipt of the request.

6.1., Right of access by the data subject

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and the following information:

- the purposes of the processing;
- the categories of personal data concerned;
- the recipients or categories of recipient to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, in particular recipients in third countries or international organisations;
- where possible, the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period;
- the existence of the right to request from the controller rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning the data subject or to object to such processing;
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;

6.2., Right to rectification

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller without undue delay the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her. Taking into account the purposes of the processing, the data subject shall have the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement.

6.3., Right to restriction of processing

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing where one of the following applies:

- the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data;
- the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead;

- the controller no longer needs the personal data for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims;
- the data subject has objected to processing pursuant to Article 21(1) pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the controller override those of the data subject.

6.4., Right to object

The data subject shall have the right to object, on grounds relating to his or her particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her which is based on point (e) or (f) of Article 6(1), including profiling based on those provisions. The controller shall no longer process the personal data unless the controller demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Where personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, the data subject shall have the right to object at any time to processing of personal data concerning him or her for such marketing, which includes profiling to the extent that it is related to such direct marketing.

6.5., Right to erasure

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her without undue delay and the controller shall have the obligation to erase personal data without undue delay where one of the following grounds applies:

- the personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
- the data subject withdraws consent on which the processing is based according to point (a) of Article 6(1), or point (a) of Article 9(2), and where there is no other legal ground for the processing;
- the data subject objects to the processing pursuant to Article 21(1) and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing, or the data subject objects to the processing pursuant to Article 21(2);
- the personal data have been unlawfully processed;
- the personal data have to be erased for compliance with a legal obligation in Union or Member State law to which the controller is subject;

- the personal data have been collected in relation to the offer of information society services referred to in Article 8(1).

6.6., Right to data portability

The data subject shall have the right to receive the personal data concerning him or her, which he or she has provided to a controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided, where:

- the processing is based on consent pursuant to point (a) of Article 6(1) or point (a) of Article 9(2) or on a contract pursuant to point (b) of Article 6(1); and
- the processing is carried out by automated means.

7., Right of appeal

7.1. Right to contact the Data Controller

If you consider the way in which the Company handles your personal data to be infringing, we recommend that you first contact our Company with your complaint at info@nftdeb.art.

7.2. Right to complain to the supervisory authority
